Take I-75 to Rt. 129 and go west to SR 747 (Princeton-Glendale Road) and go right (north) on 747 to the first light (Princeton Road) and turn left (west).

Go one mile to the first light and make a right onto Liberty-Fairfield Road. Go to Stoneybrook Dr. (about 1/4 mile) and make a left, go one block to Cavalcade and go right...she is several houses down on the left.
